## **Beyond Science and Decision Workshop XV November 13, 14, and 15, 2024**

### About the workshop Series

- Since 2010, the Alliance for Risk Assessment has sponsored a workshop series titled Beyond Science & Decisions: From Problem Formulation to Comprehensive Risk Assessment. Building on the ideas of the National Academy of Sciences' (NAS) Science & Decisions: Advancing Risk Assessment (2009), fourteen previous workshops brought together over 60 organizations seeking to advance the NAS recommendations that encourage stakeholder involvement at all stages of the risk assessment process.

### Workshop XV Objectives

- To use a multi-stakeholder approach to share information on differing risk assessments that are supporting the development of widely different regulations.
- To promote discussion on chemistries, such as those that:
  - o Reflect relevant biology and mode of action.
  - o Describe assumptions, strengths, and limitations of relevant data.
  - o Consider population and human variability, including underlying disease.
  - o Harmonize the underlying basis for risk assessments.
- To discuss how rulemaking processes are impacted given the current diversity in scientific opinion and resulting risk assessments.

### How to Attend

We are accepting registration beginning July 10, 2024. The workshop will be held over 2.5 days. Attendees will include regulators, corporate scientists, environmental lawyers, and professors.

The admission fee is \$300 (except for government and NGO employees without funding). Refreshments and lunches will also be provided.
